The JOTA (Jamboree On The Air) is an annual event during which Scouts throughout the world meet each other through amateur radio contacts. JOTI (Jamboree On The Internet) is another event where Scouts make contacts using the Computers and Internet. JOTA/JOTI contributes to better understanding and mutual respect between youngsters in different countries. This annual event is sponsored by the World Scout Bureau. Thousands of amateur radio stations around the world participate.

### Who should attend?

All Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Venture Scouts and Adult Leaders, family and friends are invited.

### How to Attend JOTA:

Come to one of the JOTA stations on Saturday, October 16<sup>th</sup> between 9:00 AM and 3:00 PM. Wear your Scout uniform if you can, though it is not mandatory.

### JOTA Stations in the Circle Ten Council Area:

JOTA Radio stations are organized at different locations throughout the Circle Ten Council area. Please refer to the list of JOTA locations. It is also published at the Circle Ten Council's web site, under the International section.

### How to Attend JOTI:

This activity can be done at home individually, or at the Troop/Pack level as a group activity. It requires only a computer (desktop or laptop). Please go to the web site <http://www.joti.org/> and sign up for JOTI user-name. More details are available at this web site.

### JOTA / JOTI Patches and Contact Cards:

The JOTA contact cards are 10 cents each, and are a good place to record some of the contacts made during JOTA. The patches are temporary insignia to be worn on the right pocket of the Scout uniform or on jackets/vests, and they cost \$4 each.

Both the contact cards and patches are available now to purchase. Checks or money orders will be accepted and must be made payable to Boy Scouts of America. They also accept most major credit cards.
